

Report of Bullying

Indiana law defines **bullying** as **overt, unwanted, repeated acts or gestures**, including verbal or written communications or images transmitted in any manner (including digitally or electronically), physical acts committed, aggression, or any other behaviors, that are committed by a student or group of students against another student with the **intent to harass, ridicule, humiliate, intimidate, or harm** the targeted student and **create for that student an objectively hostile school environment** that: **1)** places the targeted student in reasonable fear of harm to the targeted student's person or property; **2)** has a substantial detrimental effect on the targeted student's physical or mental health; **3)** has the effect of substantially interfering with the targeted student's academic performance; **or 4)** has the effect of substantially interfering with the targeted student's ability to participate in or benefit from the services, activities and privileges provided by the school.
